

STUDIO ONE Artists Development Space Information for applicants

Plymouth Arts Centre is inviting proposals from artists who are making work in the city to utilise its main studio space for up to six consecutive days.

Studio One is our largest space (approx 9 x 5m) and is being offered as a subsidised development space for artists living or working in Plymouth.

Please note: Studio One is also used by Plymouth Arts Centre for programmed activity; applicants will need to be flexible on the timings within their proposal and understand that there are some restrictions on how the space can be used. Studio One is accessed via a number of steps.

Criteria

We are looking for proposals from artists who can utilise this space for a short period of time for the advancement of their practice. For example: this may include the production of work, the development of a performance piece, organisation of a portfolio, preparation for an exhibition or any other ideas that are appropriate for the artist's development.

When selecting artists for Studio One the following criteria will be considered:

- The applicant's current practice and the potential for development.
- Availability of the space.
- The artist's ideas and plans for using the space.

Restrictions

- Studio One is offered as a development space and is not intended to be a space for the public exhibition of work or for public workshops.
- The space is available for a maximum of 6 consecutive days, dependant on availability.
- Access to this space is only available during Plymouth Arts Centre opening hours 10am – 8pm Tuesday to Sunday.
- The space needs to be left in the same condition that it was found and artists should be willing to make the space available for evening events.
- Plymouth Arts Centre will not store any work, materials or equipment beyond the period of usage.
- Applicants should be practicing artists and not in full time education.
- The Studio One project provides artists with the use of a space but does not include any further support from Plymouth Arts Centre.

Application process

N.B. Studio one is regularly used by Plymouth Arts Centre and is also hired out. We will endeavour to allow access to this space when the artists requires but if your proposal is accepted we cannot necessarily guarantee the days that you request. Applicants should not apply to use the space for longer than it is actually required, as it will be easier to provide space for a few days as opposed to six.
